# Nowhere in Scripture is there a Resurrection for Millennial Saints - Matthew 25:31-46

#### Is. 9:6-7

6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

7 Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

### Dan. 4:34-35

34 And at the end of the days I Nebuchad-nezzar lifted up mine eyes unto heaven, and mine under-standing returned unto me, and I blessed the most High, and I praised and honoured him that liveth for ever, whose dominion is an everlasting dominion, and his kingdom is from generation to generation:

35 And all the inhabitants of the earth are reputed as nothing: and he doeth according to his will in the army of heaven, and among the inhabitants of the earth: and none can stay his hand, or say unto him, What doest thou?

Duet. 7:9 - Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he is God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations;  $(1,000 \times 70 = 70,000)$ 

Psa 105:6 - O ye seed of Abraham his servant, ye children of Jacob his chosen.

Psa 105:7 - He is the LORD our God: his judgments are in all the earth.

Psa 105:8 - He hath remembered his covenant forever, the word which he commanded to a **thousand generations**.

# "Will there be sex in the new Heaven and new Earth?"

In Rev. 21:3-4, 24-26 the men and nations mentioned are natural peoples for the tabernacle of God comes down to dwell among men and God shall wipe away all tears, etc. Such would not be true if these men were glorified saints, for God has been dwelling with them for 1,000 years before these Scriptures are fulfilled.

The Earth was created to be inhabited by natural beings and natural man was promised the Earth as an eternal inheritance from the very beginning (Ex. 32:13; Ps. 25:13; 37:9-11, 22, 29, 34; 69:36; 82:8; Isa. 60:21; Matt. 5:5; 25:34). All these passages were spoken to earthly people and will be fulfilled when earthly people inherit the Earth after the Millennium. Glorified saints will reign as kings and priests under Christ over these earthly peoples forever (Dan. 7:13-14, 18-27; Isa. 9:6-7; Luke 1:32-35; 1 Cor. 6:2; Rev. 5:9-10; 11:15; 20:4-10).

Those people who live on Earth during the Millennium will not be glorified and enter into the same priviliges as the saints who have part in the first resurrection and who were glorified before the Millennium, for if the earthly people were glorified then who would be the subjects of the eternal kingdom that Christ and the premillennial glorified saints rule over?

Who would marry and reproduce the natural generations of men on the eternal earth? God created man to live forever in the natural body, as is clear from the fact that man would have lived a natural life forever if he had not sinned and fallen short of the glory of God. The penalty from man's sin was death-----physical, spiritual and eternal death. However, the fall of man did not cause God to change His original and eternal plan for mankind on Earth. God cannot and will not in the end suffer defeat.

The Bible plainly declares there will be eternal generations of natural peoples (Gen. 9:12; 13:15; 17:7-8, 19; Ex. 3:15; 12:14, 42; 27:21; 30:8, 21; 31:16; 40:15; Lev. 3:17; 6:18; 10:9; 17:7; 23:14, 21, 31, 41; 24:3; 25:30; Num. 10:8; 15:15; 18:23; Deut. 5:29; 12:28; 28:46; 29:29; 2 Sam.7:24-29; 1 Chron. 23:25; Ps. 12:7; 45:17; 72:5; 79:13; 89:4; 100:5; 012:12, 24; 106:31; 119:90; 135:13; 145:13; 146:10; Isa. 9:6-7; 51:8; 59:21; Jer. 31:35-36; 32:38-40; Ezek. 37:24-28; Lam. 5:19; Dan. 2:44-45; 4:3, 34; 7:13-18; Joel 3:20; Luke 1:32-35. 55; Rev. 5:10; 11:15).

# **Full List of Resurrections in the Bible**

I have previously discussed how many future resurrections there are in the Bible, focusing specifically on the theology behind resurrection. However, I also thought it would be helpful to list all of the resurrections that are mentioned in Scripture for reference.

Resurrection of the widow's son in Zarephath (1 Kgs 17:17–22)

Resurrection of the Shunammite's son (2 Kgs 4:18–37)

Resurrection of the man thrown into Elisha's grave (2 Kgs 13:20)

Resurrection of Jairus' daughter (Mark 5:41)

Resurrection of the young man at Nain (Luke 7:14)

Resurrection of Lazarus (John 11:38–44)

Resurrection of unknown saints during the crucifixion (Matt 27:52-53)

Resurrection of Christ (Matt 28:1-6)

Resurrection of Tabitha/Dorcas (Acts 9:36–42)

Resurrection of Eutychus (Acts 20:7–12)

Resurrection of the Church (i.e., Rapture, 1 Thess 4:13-18; 1 Cor 15:23)

Resurrection of the Two Witnesses (Rev 11:7–11)

Resurrection of OT Saints and Martyrs (Revelation 20:4)

Resurrection of the Wicked (Revelation 20:5)

With the final judgment meted out on the White Throne where heaven and earth have passed away, the all wise Creator God of time and history will usher in the eternal age of the Kingdom of God and heaven reunited as one:

Then cometh the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father, when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power. For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet. The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death. For he hath put all things under his feet. But when he saith all things are put under him, it is manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him. And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that God may be all in all. (1 Corinthians 15:24-28)

Here finally death, the last enemy is destroyed:

And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire. (Revelation 20:14&15)

With the second death meted out to those rebels in time and history of the old world, death and hell cast into the lake of fire, death vanishes from the future reality. Death enters because of sin but in the eternal age, sin and death are forever eradicated from the real world of glory and bliss. Here comes the brand-new world in eternity. An era of perfect holiness and blessedness in everlasting glory where the presence of God is permanent for all His creatures is finally dawning upon a new world.

And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God. And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away. (Revelation 21:1-4)

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. Earth and heaven go together, and the sun and moon and the stars are secondary in God's creation. The first heaven and first earth are a thing of the past. The new heaven and new earth are here to stay. Here, God is still emphasizing on heaven and earth and not the sun, moon, and stars.
